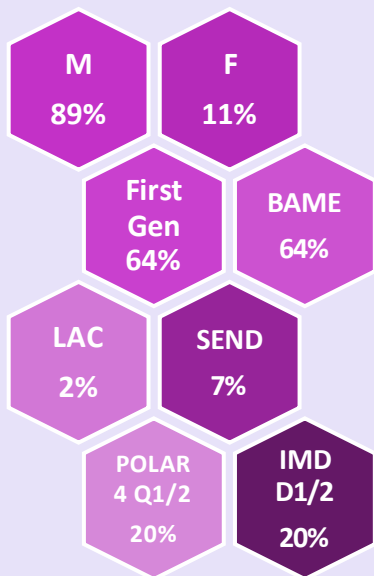


LPP Feedback of learner events 2019/20:

Key Stage 5: Y13 Preparing to Apply to UCAS Sept 2019 at Goldsmiths University – 45 Learners attended:



82% felt that the event had encouraged them to think MORE about their future and how to get there
80% felt now MORE LIKELY that they will choose the most appropriate course and HEI for them

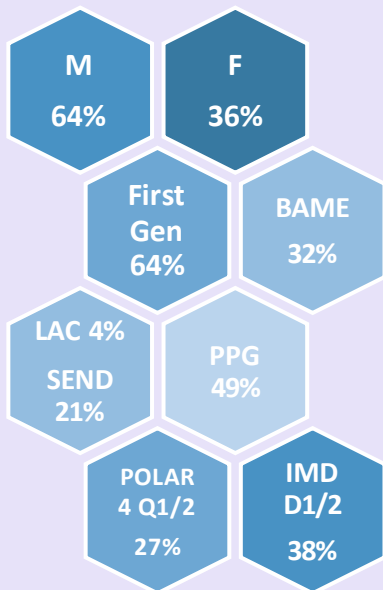


87% found Personal Statement workshops with HEIs USEFUL with 47% of those finding it VERY useful

87% Found the Student Life workshop by St Mary's ENJOYABLE

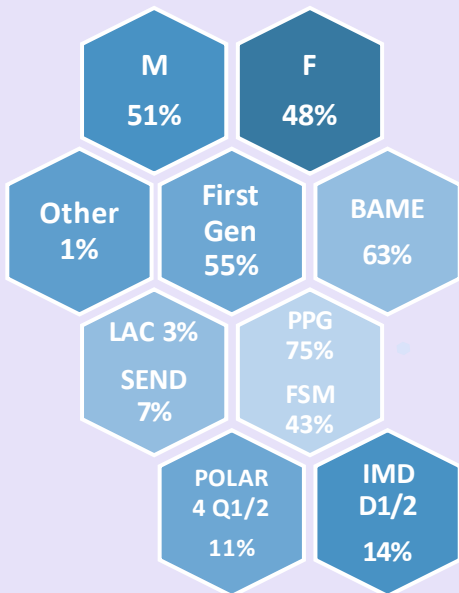


98% are now MORE aware of what they can do at a university with 68% being MUCH MORE aware

73% Found the Student Life workshop by St Mary's ENJOYABLE

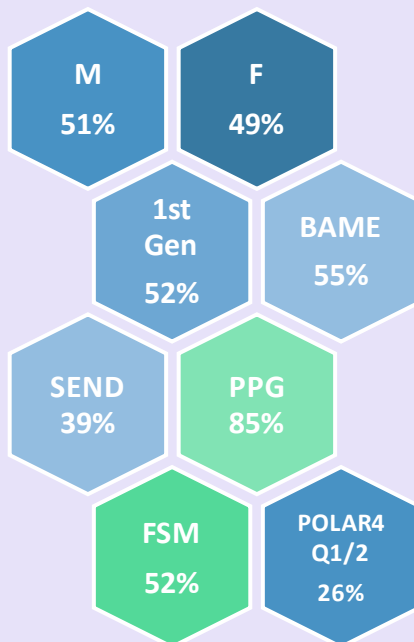


78% are now MORE aware of what they can do at a university with 41% being MUCH MORE aware

66% Found the Campus Trail ENJOYABLE with 33% of those finding it VERY ENJOYABLE

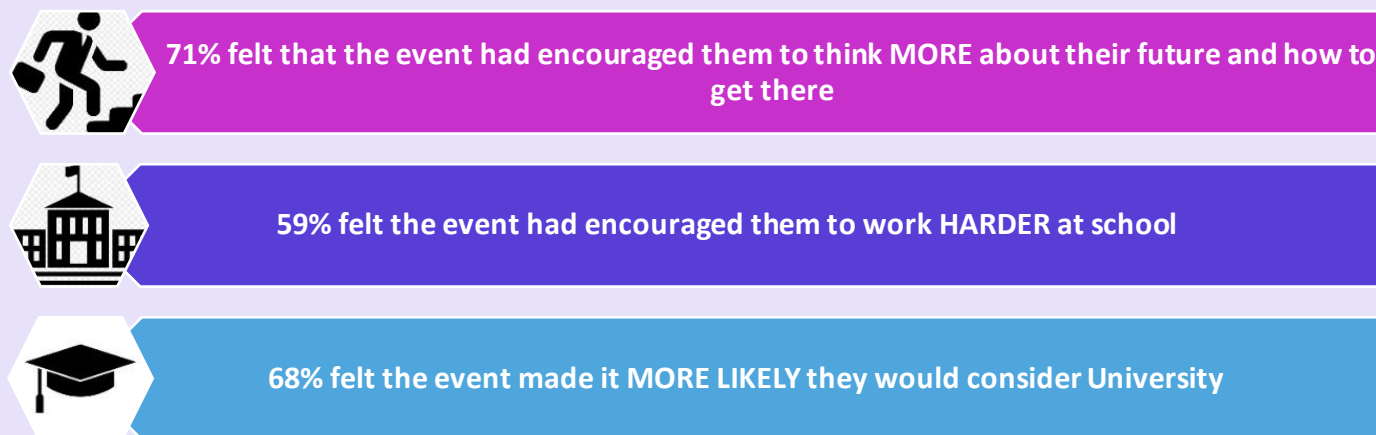
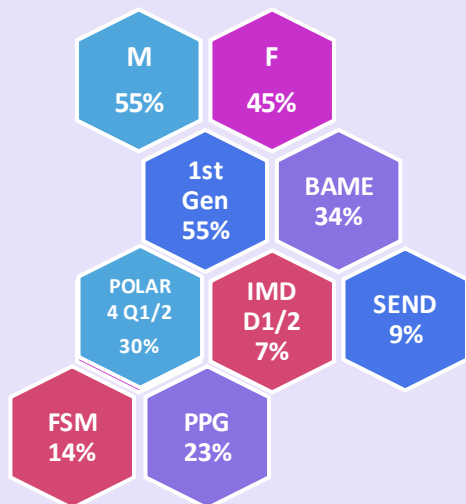


87% are now MORE aware of courses they can study at university with 32% being MUCH MORE aware
91% are now MORE aware of how subjects they study now connect to university courses

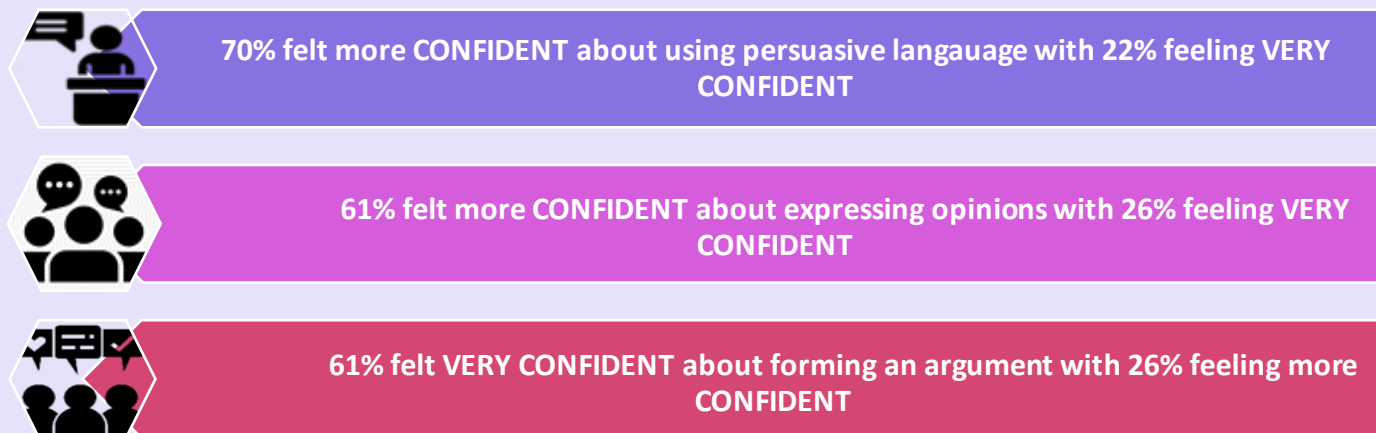
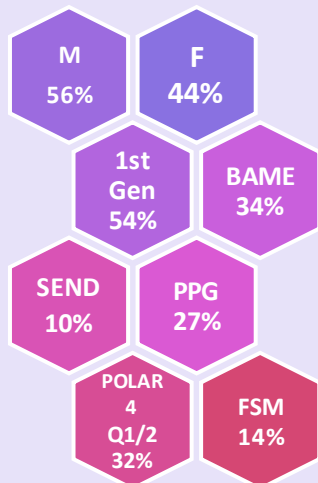


86% are now MORE aware of what careers studying at university can lead to
